ORIGIN : Great Britain.

DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL VALID STANDARD : 28.07.2009.

<u>UTILIZATION</u> : Gundog.

<u>FCI-CLASSIFICATION</u>: Group 8 Retrievers, Flushing Dogs, Water Dogs. Section 1 Retrievers. With working trial.

<u>**GENERAL APPEARANCE**</u> : Symmetrical, balanced, active, powerful, level mover; sound with kindly expression.

<u>BEHAVIOUR / TEMPERAMENT</u> : Biddable, intelligent and possessing natural working ability; kindly, friendly and confident.

<u>HEAD</u> : Balanced and well chiselled.

<u>CRANIAL REGION</u> : <u>Skull</u> : Broad without coarseness; well set on neck. <u>Stop</u> : Well defined.

<u>FACIAL REGION</u> : Nose : Preferably black.

<u>Muzzle</u> : Powerful, wide and deep. Length of foreface approximately equals length from stop to occiput.

<u>Jaws/Teeth</u> : Jaws strong, with a perfect, regular and complete scissor bite, i.e. upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws.

Eyes : Dark brown, set well apart, dark rims.

Ears : Moderate size, set on approximate level with eyes.

<u>NECK</u> : Good length, clean and muscular.

BODY : Balanced. <u>Back</u> : Level topline. <u>Loins</u> : Strong, muscular, short-coupled. Chest : Deep through heart. Ribs deep, well sprung.

<u>**TAIL</u>** : Set on and carried level with back, reaching to hocks, without curl at tip.</u>

LIMBS

FOREQUARTERS :

<u>General appearance</u> : Forelegs straight with good bone.

Shoulder : Well laid back, long in blade.

<u>Upper arm</u> : Of equal length as the shoulder blade, placing legs well under body.

Elbow : Close fitting.

Forefeet : Round and cat-like.

<u>HINDQUARTERS</u> : <u>General appearance</u> : Hindlegs strong and muscular. <u>Stifle</u> : Well bent. <u>Lower thigh</u> : Good. <u>Hock</u> : Well let down, straight when viewed from rear, neither turning in nor out. Cow-hocks highly undesirable. <u>Hind feet</u> : Round and cat-like.

<u>GAIT / MOVEMENT</u>: Powerful with good drive. Straight and true in front and rear. Stride long and free with no sign of hackney action in front.

<u>COAT</u>

<u>Hair</u> : Flat or wavy with good feathering, dense water-resisting undercoat.

<u>COLOUR</u> : Any shade of gold or cream, neither red nor mahogany. A few white hairs on chest only, permissible.

SIZE AND WEIGHT :

<u>Height at withers</u>: Dogs 56 - 61 cm (22-24 ins); Bitches 51 - 56 cm (20-22 ins).

 \underline{FAULTS} : Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog **and on its ability to perform its traditional work.**

DISQUALIFYING FAULTS:

- Aggressive or overly shy.
- Any dog clearly showing physical or behavioural abnormalities shall be disqualified.

<u>N.B</u>.:

- Male animals should have two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum.
- Only functionally and clinically healthy dogs, with breed typical conformation should be used for breeding.

ANATOMICAL FEATURES
